Fabric Requirements

Fabric A outer border	1½ yards	4356-K	4356-N
Fabric B inner border	1¼ yards	4357-L	4357-N
Fabric C blocks and border	¾ yard	4358-L	4358-N
Fabric D blocks	¾ yard	4359-L	4359-T
Fabric E blocks	1⅛ yards	4360-K	4360-T
Fabric F blocks and inner border	¾ yard	4362-P	4362-P
Fabric G* center border	¾ yard	4362-T	4362-T
Fabric H blocks	⅓ yard	4361-T	4361-L
Fabric I blocks	¼ yard	1867-P4	1867-G3
Fabric J blocks	¼ yard	4361-L	1867-LG
Fabric K Backing	3¾ yards	4359-L	4359-T

Cutting Directions

Note: To make cutting the ribbon stripe pieces easier and more accurate, we have provided templates with centering lines. Position templates with the line in the exact center of the stripe to determine cutting position of the lengthwise stripe strips. Border measurements are given in the exact lengths required, including ¼" seam allowances. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

- Fabric A** Cut (4) strips 6½" x 46½" on the length of the fabric
- Fabric B** Cut (4) strips 4½" x 36½" along the length of the fabric with a stripe motif centered in each strip
- Fabric C** Cut (8) squares 4¾" x 4¾", fussy cut with chicken motif centered on the diagonal of each square
- Fabric D** Cut (10) squares 5⅛" x 5⅛" and cut in half once diagonally to make triangles
Cut (16) center frame pieces using template
- Fabric E** Cut (32) triangles with dashed line on template aligned with center of larger stripe motif
Cut (20) center frame pieces with dashed line on template aligned with center of larger stripe motif
- Fabric F** Cut (8) squares 5⅛" x 5⅛" and cut in half once diagonally to make triangles
Cut (4) squares 4½" x 4½"
- Fabric G** Cut (5) strips 1½" x WOF, pieced together to make the following: 2 borders 1½" x 44½" and 2 borders 1½" x 46½"
Cut (6) strips 2½" x WOF for binding
- Fabric H** Cut squares (20) 3⅞" x 3⅞" and cut in half once diagonally to make triangles

Fabric I Cut (10) squares 3⅞" x 3⅞" and cut in half once diagonally to make triangles

Fabric J Cut (8) squares 3⅞" x 3⅞" and cut in half once diagonally to make triangles

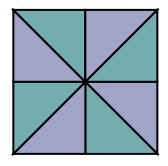
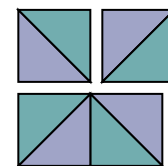
Backing Cut (2) panels 42" x 66" and piece to fit quilt top with 4" overlap on all sides.

Making the Pinwheel Blocks

- Sew a fabric H triangle to a fabric I triangle to make an H-I unit. Press seam allowance toward the fabric I triangle. Repeat to make 20 H-I units.
- Join four H-I units to make a pinwheel referring to Diagram 1. Press seam allowances to one side. Repeat to make a total of five pinwheel units.

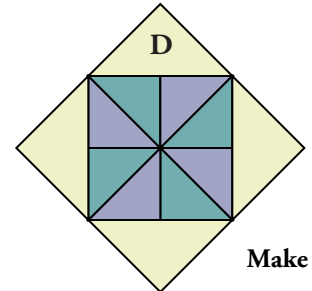

Diagram 1- Block A

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- Referring to Diagram 2, sew a fabric F triangle to each side of each pinwheel unit; press seams toward fabric D triangles.
- Sew a fabric E center frame piece to a fabric H triangle to complete an E-H corner unit. Press seam allowance toward the triangle. Repeat to make a total of 20 E-H corner units.
- Sew an E-H corner unit to each side of each previously stitched unit to complete a total of five Pinwheel blocks. Press seam allowances toward the corner units.

Making Chicken Blocks

- Referring to Diagram 3, sew a fabric E triangle to each side of a fabric C square to complete a chicken unit. Press seam allowances toward fabric E triangles. Repeat to make eight chicken units. Set aside four chicken units for outer border.
- Sew an F triangle to each side of each pieced chicken unit. Press seam allowances toward the fabric F triangles.
- Sew a fabric D center frame piece to a fabric J triangle to complete a D-J corner unit. Press seam allowance toward the fabric J triangle. Repeat to make a total of 16 D-J corner units.
- Sew a D-J corner unit to each side of each previously stitched unit to complete a total of four Chicken blocks. Press seam allowances toward the corner units.

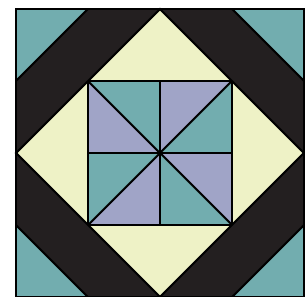
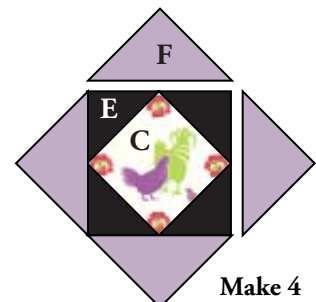


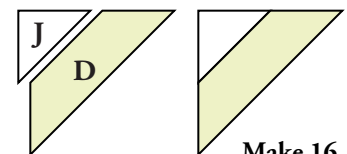

Quilt Assembly

- Referring to the Assembly Diagram, arrange and join the blocks to make three rows, keeping the chicken units in each Chicken block upright in the rows. Press seam allowances toward Pinwheel blocks. Join the rows to complete the pieced center. Press seam allowances in one direction.
- Sew a $36\frac{1}{2}$ " fabric B border strip to opposite sides of the pieced center. Press seam allowances toward fabric B strips. Sew a $4\frac{1}{2}$ " fabric F square to each end of each remaining $36\frac{1}{2}$ " fabric B border strip and press seam allowances away from the squares. Sew these strips to the top and bottom of the pieced center. Press seam allowances toward the strips.
- Sew the $44\frac{1}{2}$ " fabric G border strips to opposite sides and the $46\frac{1}{2}$ " fabric G border strips to the top and bottom. Press seam allowances toward fabric G strips.
- Sew the $46\frac{1}{2}$ " border fabric A border strips to opposite sides. Press seam allowances toward fabric A strips. Sew a chicken unit to each end of each remaining $46\frac{1}{2}$ " fabric A border strip, keeping the chickens upright, again referring to the Assembly Diagram. Press seam allowances toward the fabric A strips. Sew these strips to the top and bottom of the pieced center. Press seam allowances toward the fabric A strips.

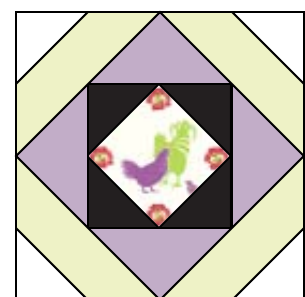
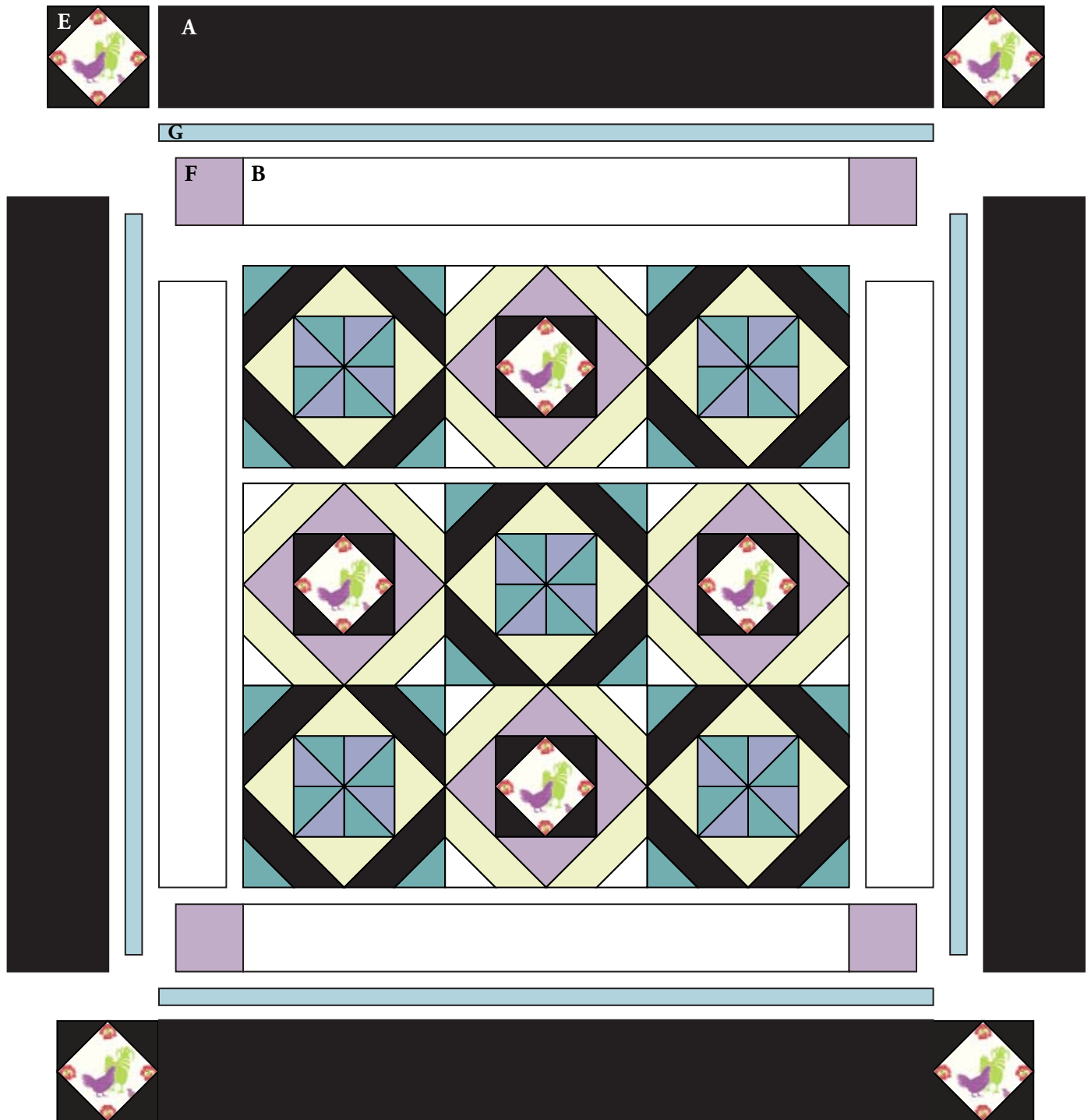

- Layer quilt top with batting and backing. Quilt in the ditch of seams and as desired. Bind to finish the quilt.

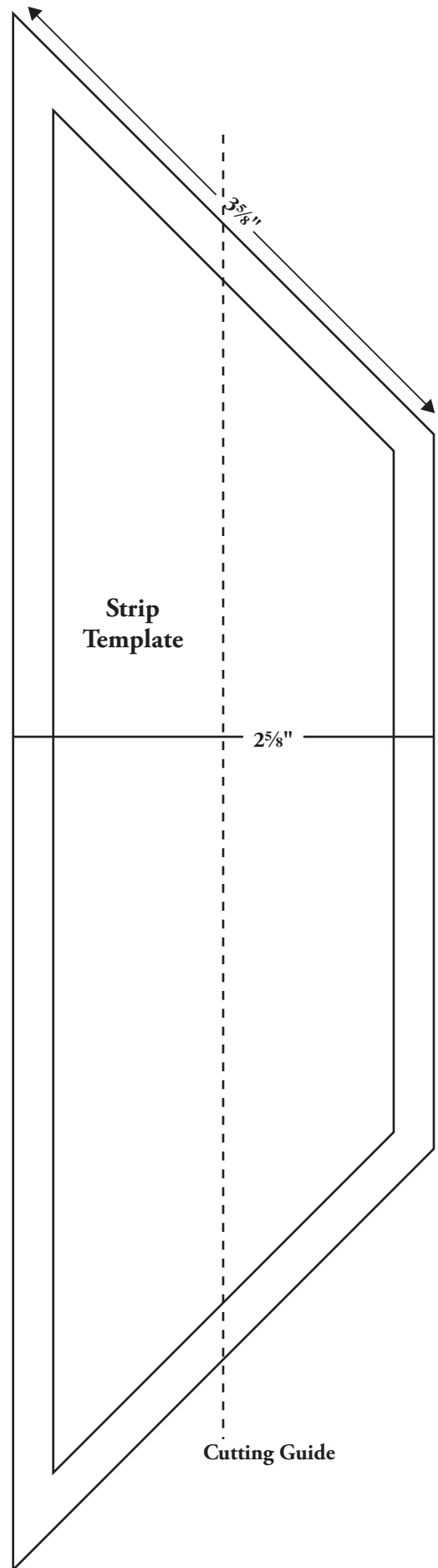
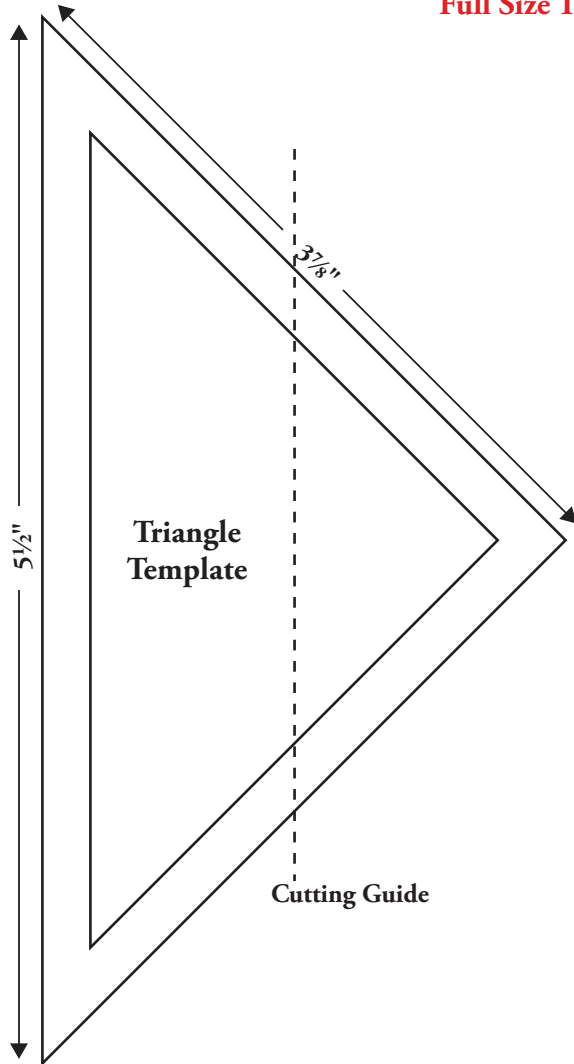
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Quilt Diagram

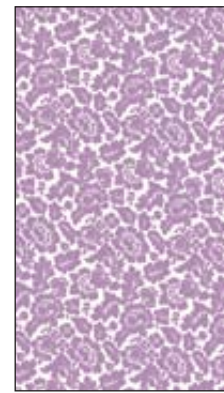

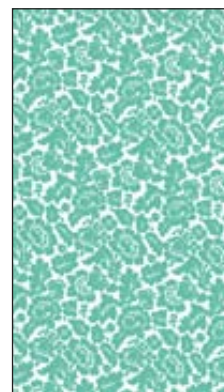
