Quilt finishes 63½" x 83"
32 Blocks: 6" x 6"

What quilter doesn't love scrap quilts? These fabrics from Jo's latest line of reproduction fabrics blend together in a harmonious mix. The traditional blocks are joined in a strippy setting that presents the gorgeous large-scale striped prints to their best advantage. We suggest that you cut patches for one block at a time, stitch it, and put it up on your design wall to admire the growing display.

Cutting Directions

Note: All cutting for blocks is listed beside each block diagram. All measurements are cut sizes and include ¼" seam allowances. A fat ⅛ is a 9" x 20"-22" cut of fabric. A fat ¼ is an 18" x 20"-22" cut. Borders are cut the exact lengths required plus ¼" seam allowances. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

Fabric A Fussy-cut (1) center sash 7½" x 68½"
Fussy-cut (2) side sashes 4¼" x 68½"

Fabric B Cut (2) side borders 6¼" x 71½"
Cut (2) top/bottom borders 6¼" x 63½"
Save remaining fabric for block patches

Fabric C Cut (6) strips 2" x WOF, pieced to make the following:
(2) side borders 2" x 68½"
(2) top/bottom borders 2" x 52"
Cut (8) strips 2½" x WOF for binding
Save remaining fabric for block patches

Fabric D Cut (14) squares 9¾", cut in half diagonally twice to make 56 quarter-square triangles
Cut (8) squares 5⅛", cut in half diagonally to make 16 half-square triangles

Fabric E Cut (2) panels 36" x 91", pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides
Save remaining fabric for block patches

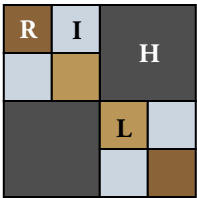

Block Diagrams

Hint: Cut largest patches (4¼", 3¼", or 2⅞" squares) before cutting smaller patches from individual fabrics. Cut patches for 1 block at a time and either sew the block or put the patches in a sandwich bag. Keeping the patches separate for each block will prevent mix-ups later.

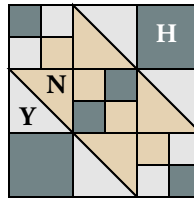

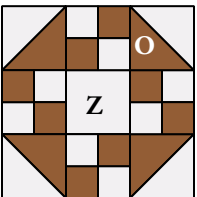
Steps to the Altar

Fabric B Cut 2 squares 2⅞", cut in half diagonally to make 4 triangles (1 not used)
 Cut 2 squares 2½"
 Cut 3 squares 1⅞", cut in half diagonally to make 6 triangles
 Cut 6 squares 1½"
 Fabric E Cut 1 square 2⅞", cut in half diagonally to make 2 triangles
 Fabric Y Cut 9 squares 1½"



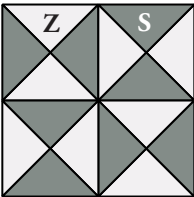

- Fabric N Cut 3 squares $3\frac{1}{4}$ ", cut in half diagonally twice to make 12 triangles

Scrap Basket Sampler Quilt

Making and Assembling the Quilt

1. Referring to the block diagrams, cut the patches for each block as needed. For some blocks, you will need to make half-square triangle units (HST) or flying geese units (FG). Some squares are cut diagonally into half-square or quarter-square triangles, as directed in the list.

Half-Square Triangles The blocks use half-square triangles (HST) that finish different sizes. Because of the small size of the HST, you may prefer to cut squares slightly larger and trim the HST to the correct size as follows: The cut $1\frac{7}{8}$ " squares are trimmed to $1\frac{1}{2}$ " after stitching and pressing and result in finished 1" HST. Likewise, $2\frac{3}{8}$ " cut squares are trimmed to 2" to finish $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square; $2\frac{7}{8}$ " cut squares are trimmed to $2\frac{1}{2}$ " to finish 2"; $3\frac{3}{8}$ " cut squares are trimmed to 3" to finish $2\frac{1}{2}$ ". Use your favorite method to make HST, or follow these directions. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each lighter fabric square (Diagram 1). Place a marked square on a second square, right sides together. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on each side of the marked line; cut apart on the marked line. Press open to make 2 pieced HST.

Flying Geese Some blocks use a fast method for making Flying Geese units (FG). Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each small square. Place a marked square on one end of the appropriate rectangle, right sides together. Sew on the marked line; trim away and discard excess fabric (Diagram 2). Press open. Repeat this process on the opposite end of the rectangle, stitching in mirror image (Diagram 3) to make a Flying Geese unit.

Woodbox This block uses a fast corner method. After sewing the T and I rectangles to the center AA patch position a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square in a corner of the block. Stitch diagonally and trim off the excess (Diagram 4). Repeat in each corner (Diagram 5).

2. Once the 32 blocks are made, arrange them on a design wall or flat surface in vertical rows in the order shown in the Quilt Diagram or as you wish. Position the Fabric D triangles where needed on the sides of the blocks to make diagonal units. Join the units, matching seams, to make 4 block rows.
3. Referring to the Quilt Diagram, sew the narrow sashes between block rows 1 and 2, and between rows 3 and 4. Sew the wide sash between rows 2 and 3.
4. Sew the long narrow border strips to the sides of the quilt, and sew the short narrow border strips to the top and bottom. Repeat for the outer border strips.

Finishing the Quilt

5. Layer the quilt with batting and backing; baste. Quilt in the ditch around block patches. Quilt a motif of your choice in the large triangles in the blocks. Bind to finish the quilt.

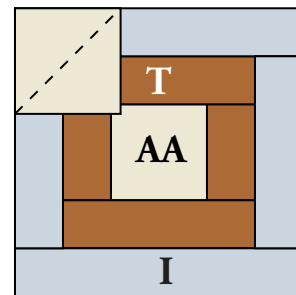

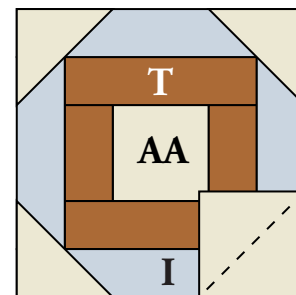
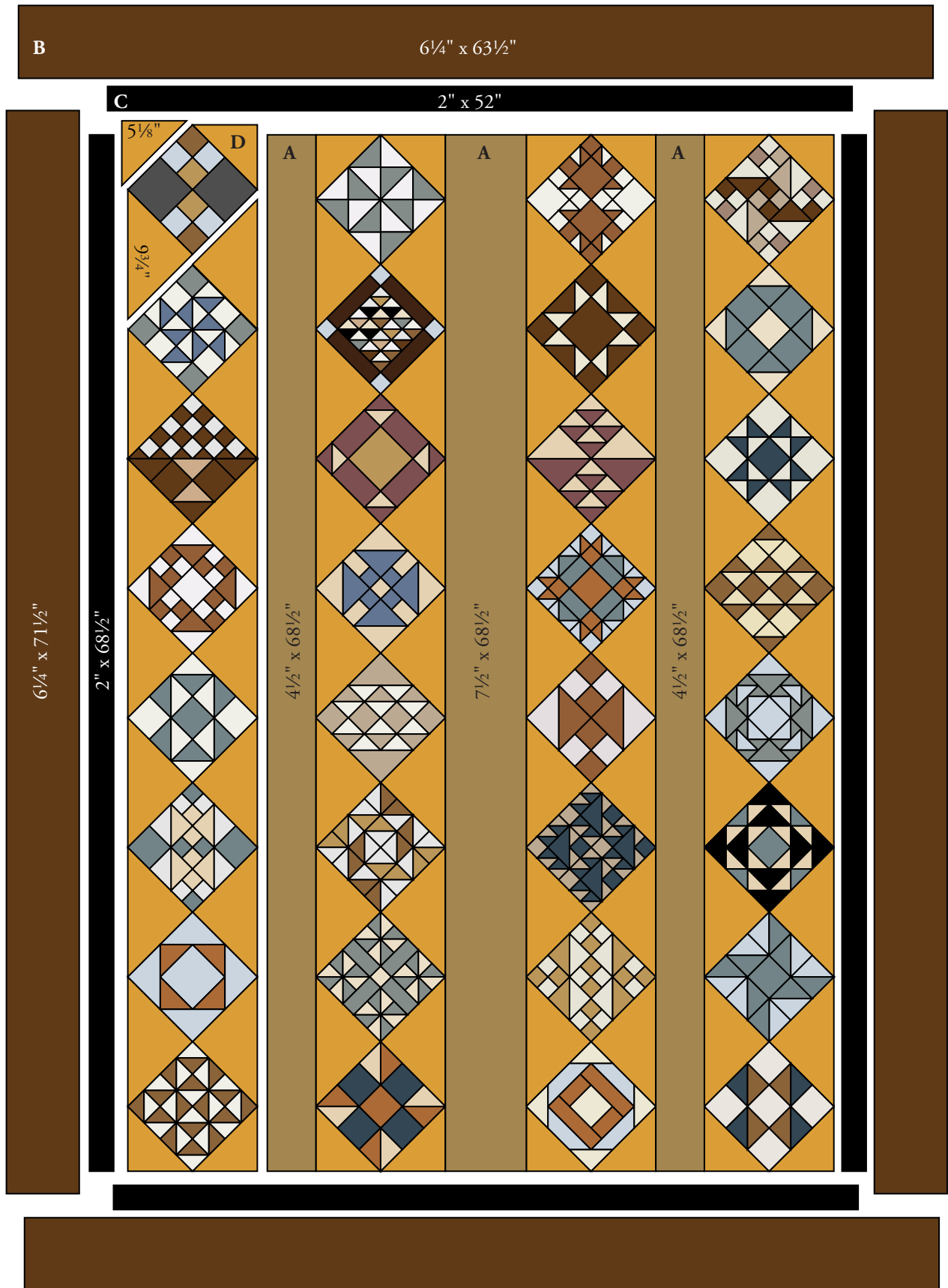


Diagram 5. Woodbox
