Quilt finishes 56" x 72"

10 Block W: 6" x 6"

8 Block X: 6" x 6"

14 Block Y: 8" x 8"

14 Block Z: 8" x 8"

Hear them roar! Majestic tigers roam the jungle in this twin/throw-size quilt. The exotic prints enhance the powerful images in the center. The blocks are uncomplicated enough for a beginning quilter.

Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include 1/4" seam allowances. Borders are cut the exact lengths required plus 1/4" seam allowances. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

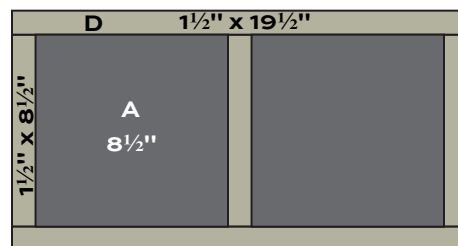
- Fabric A** Fussy-cut (1) tiger panel 17 1/2" x 20 1/2"
Fussy-cut (4) tiger squares 8 1/2" x 8 1/2"
- Fabric B** Cut (14) squares 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" for Block Z
- Fabric C** Cut (10) squares 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" for Block W
- Fabric D** Cut (28) rectangles 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" for Block Y
Cut (28) rectangles 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" for Block Y
Cut (2) sashes 1 1/2" x 20 1/2"
Cut (4) sashes 1 1/2" x 19 1/2"
Cut (6) sashes 1 1/2" x 8 1/2"
- Fabric E** Cut (7) strips 2 1/2" x WOF for binding
Cut (2) borders 1 1/2" x 54 1/2", cut crosswise and pieced
Cut (2) borders 1 1/2" x 40 1/2"
Cut (2) sashes 1 1/2" x 26 1/2"
- Fabric F** Cut (32) squares 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" for Block X
- Fabric G** Cut (28) rectangles 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" for Block Z
Cut (28) rectangles 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" for Block Z
- Fabric H** Cut (14) squares 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" for Block Y
- Fabric I** Cut (2) side borders 4" x 40 1/2", cut crosswise
Cut (2) t/b borders 6 1/2" x 26 1/2", cut crosswise
- Fabric J** Cut (8) squares 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" for Block X
- Fabric K** Cut (40) squares 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" for Block W
- Backing** Cut (2) panels 40" x 64", pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides

Making the Quilt

- Referring to the Quilt Diagram, sew Fabric D 20 1/2" sashes to the sides of the tiger panel. Join 2 Fabric A 8 1/2" squares with 3 short Fabric D sashes. Sew D strips to the top and bottom to make a pieced unit (Diagram 1). Make 2. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt.

- Sew long Fabric I borders to the sides. Sew short Fabric E borders to short Fabric I borders. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt, placing black borders next to the quilt.

3. Block W and Block X are made with quick stitch-and-flip piecing methods. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each Fabric F and K $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Referring to Diagram 1, place a marked K square on a Fabric C $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square, right sides together, aligning raw edges at the corner. Stitch on the drawn line; trim away and discard excess fabric. Press open. Repeat on the opposite corner, watching orientation of the sewing (Diagram 2). Repeat on the remaining corners. Make 10 Block W. Make 8 Block X with F and J squares.

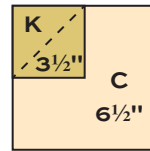

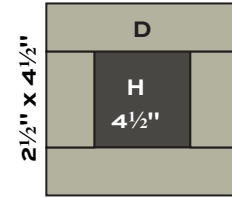

4. Referring to the Quilt Diagram, join 5 Block W with 4 Block X in a vertical row. Sew to the side of the quilt. Repeat for the opposite side.

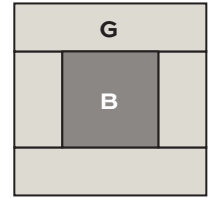
5. Sew long Fabric E borders to the sides. Sew remaining Fabric E borders to the top and bottom.

6. Referring to the Block Y and Z diagrams, sew Fabric D strips to H squares. Make 14 Block Y. Sew Fabric G strips to B squares. Make 14 Block Z.

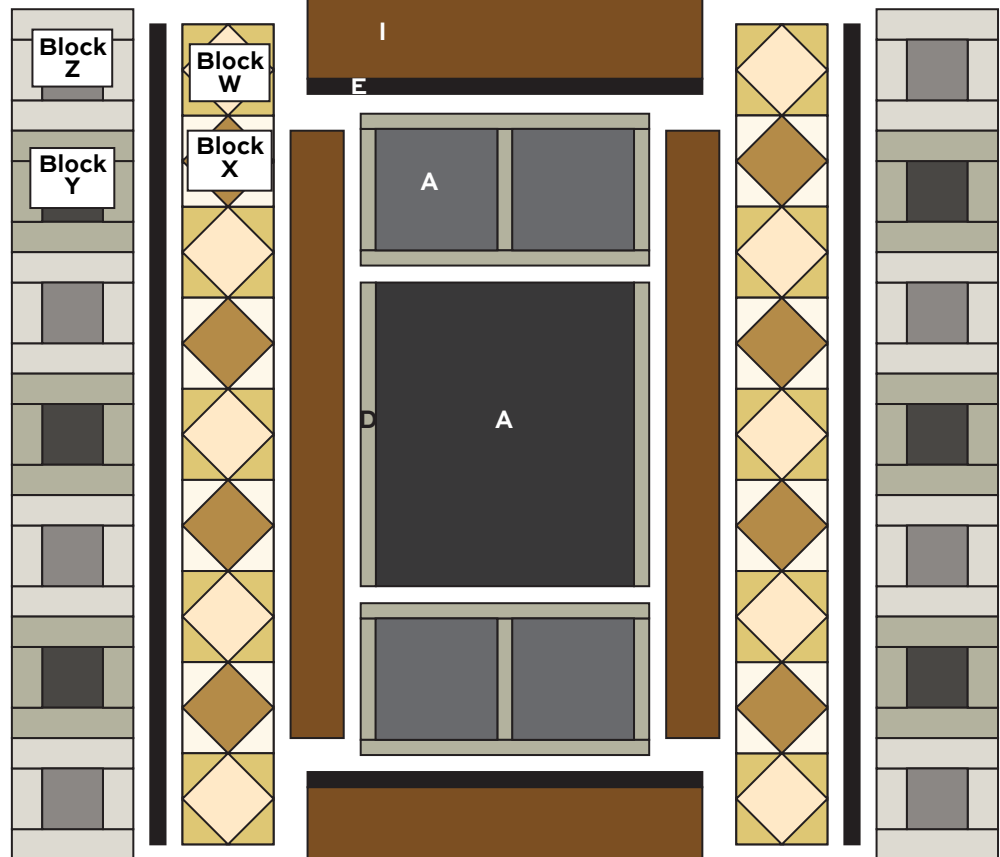

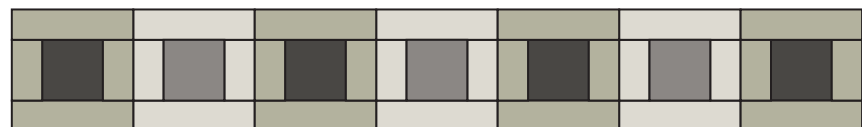

7. Referring to the Quilt Diagram, join 4 Block Z and 3 Block Y to make a vertical row, rotating the blocks as shown. Sew to the side of the quilt. Repeat for the opposite side. Join 4 Block Y and 3 Block Z to make a horizontal row. Sew to the top of the quilt. Repeat for the bottom.



Finishing the Quilt

8. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around borders and block patches. Quilt around the printed motifs in the Fabric A patches. Quilt along the printed stripes in the Fabric I borders. Bind to finish the quilt.

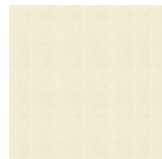

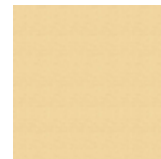
